Greetings all!

Welcome to 'Data Protection', the second episode of '@lantis: a Science Fiction Radio Play Series'. Set in a futuristic underwater city populated by scientists and academics, '@lantis' is a key part of my PhD research into Science-Fiction and Live Performance being undertaken here at Murdoch University. In 'Data Protection', the recently-promoted Security Captain Dorothy Goddard is introduced to the unofficial fifth member of the Ponderlust Labs research team – IRIS, an Artificial Intelligence with attitude. IRIS and her father/creator Prof. Jules Quine have a strained relationship which is put to the test when the Ponderlust team are confronted by threats such as wormholes, aggravated crustaceans, and the scariest foe of all: teenagers.

After the debut of the series last week with 'Fish Out of Water', I'm thrilled to be able to bring you the second episode in the series and a formal introduction to the character of IRIS. She was the last member of the Ponderlust team I wrote into the scripts for @lantis, which is why she is making her first appearance in this episode. A.I. characters have a rich history in Science-Fiction, with some my own favourites being Holly from Red Dwarf, EDI from the Mass Effect series and the villainous HAL 9000 from 2001: A Space Odyssey. Given the advancements in real-world A.I. development, the subject of "Computers that Think" is one that has proven to be popular in recent Sci-Fi films (including films such as Her and Ex Machina), and as such was selected early on in the writing process as an area of Sci-Fi I wanted to explore during the run of @lantis.

As with all of the other episodes in this series, 'Data Protection' Features artwork from our incredibly talented team of artists. This week – as with Episode One – our feature artist is Ally Snell, who has brought characters such as Lug, IRIS, and the Hybrid to life with her skills. Given that radio plays can sometimes be a little on the visually unstimulating side, we made the decision early in the design process to incorporate projected artwork on stage to accompany the performances and give an additional optical flavour to the content of the show. Keep an eye out for more of Ally's work later in the series, as well as the upcoming contributions from our other talented artists Allison Bell and Lorraine De Cruz.
